Children have been happy to come to ICM, either with mom, grandma, or a neighbor. While adults are getting groceries and picking out clothing and other basics for the family, children have time to play in ICM's Love Corner – a child-friendly play space with lots of books and toys. This summer there were free lunches available, school uniforms and school supplies.

During the months of June and July more than 1,500 children received a lunch, from pizza to chicken wraps. Children in local neighborhoods were not able to eat breakfast or lunch at school this summer because of funding cutbacks, so these hungry little people thought ICM was a great place to be. For those attending school, more than 300 uniforms were available, one per child. Volunteers also gave out school supplies – notebooks, scissors, pencils, crayons, and backpacks. The smiles on the kids' faces said it all.

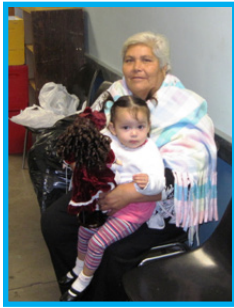

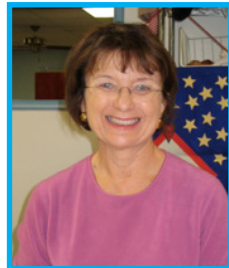
with. They come from all age and income groups and a few of them have been at ICM longer than I have. All in all, ICM is an enjoyable and meaningful place to volunteer."

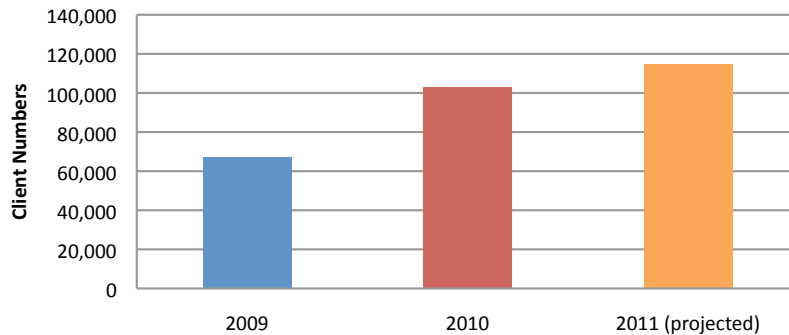

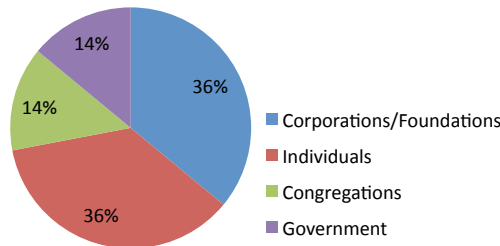
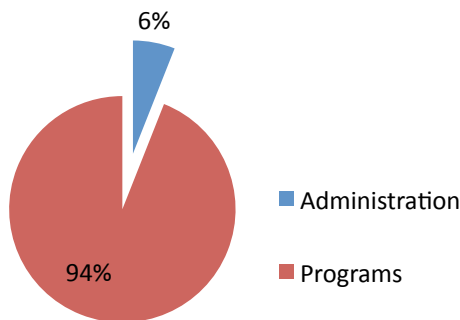
Number of Individuals Served

Note from the Director

Just when we thought it couldn't get any worse, the "recession" hangs on like a bad dream. ICM sees families in many shapes and sizes now, some who have lived at the bottom of society's ladder for a long time, maybe because of disability or a lack of education. We see some who managed to climb up a bit and then lost jobs lately, and then the elderly on fixed incomes where money doesn't go as far as it used to. But lately we've seen middle class Arizonans apologizing for being here because they lost jobs and housing, and we tell them that's why ICM is here.



The fact is, our service numbers have grown exponentially. In 2009, ICM served more than 67,000 individuals. In 2010, more than 103,000 came through our doors. This year, we are on track to surpass that record number! Our clients can come for services twice a month, they receive food boxes, clothing, toiletries, household goods, and time with a case manager. A free medical clinic each month, thanks to our friends at Cathedral Health Services, screens clients who have no health insurance.

It's cliché to say it, but we are only able to continue this business because of your compassion for what we do. Thank you so much for being in the background for the families, the disabled, and the elderly who come to us.

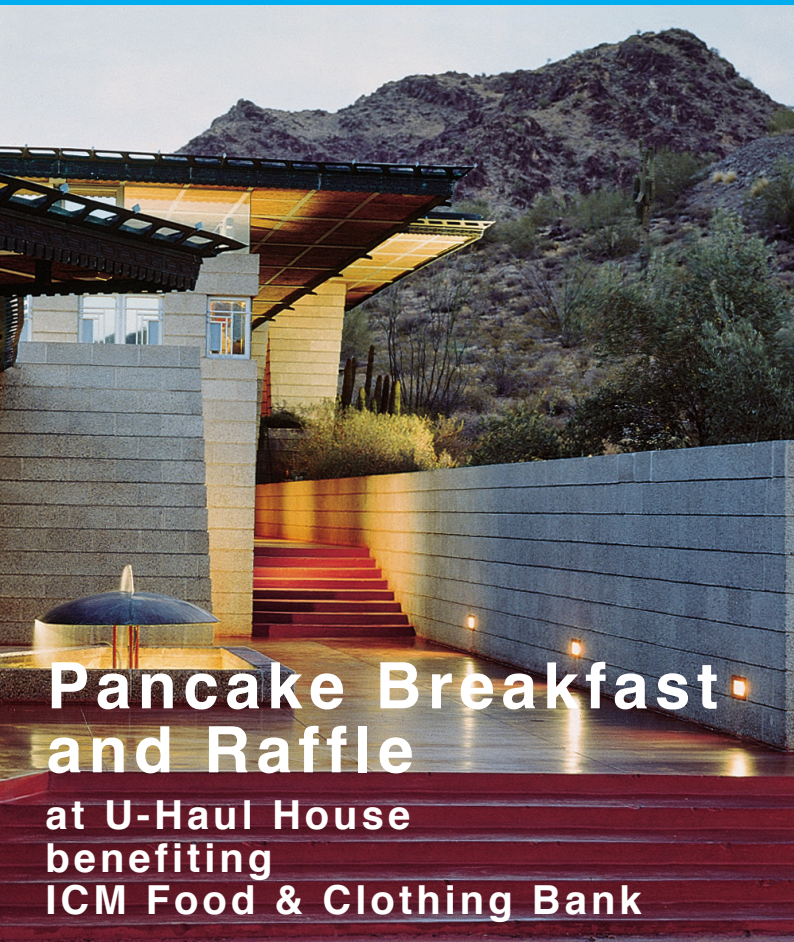
